- serves a student body of 258 kindergarten through eighth grade students that is
  - 91% Catholic
  - culturally diverse (14% African-American, 23% Asian, 19% Hispanic, 5% Pacific Islander, 22% Caucasian, and 17% multi-racial)
- supports parents in developing respectful, responsible, socially conscious children who grow in their Catholic faith
- is a fully networked facility utilizing continually upgraded technology
- emphasizes the integration of technology throughout the curriculum
- supports the acquisition of strong reading and math skills, providing reading and math intervention classes with trained intervention specialists as needed
- promotes healthy lifestyles through health classes and through a sequential physical education program taught by a qualified PE specialist
- utilizes a well-equipped, up-to-date science laboratory and a variety of science and engineering challenges to support strong science-based learning
- promotes conflict resolution skills through the use of the *Second Step, Steps to Respect*, and *Let's Get Real* programs
- promotes information literacy through research skills classes and the use of a state-of-the-art library media center
- encourages student leadership through Student Council and through student Faith Families
- utilizes instructional assistants in grades K-6
- has a 1:18 teacher-student ratio in middle school/junior high math and composition classes
- supports students with special needs through the services of a special needs coordinator and a resource teacher
- offers the services of a licensed family counselor
- provides homework support as part of the after-school extended care program
- offers quality extended care before and after school from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- provides instruction from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. for students in grades K to 4 and until 3:15 p.m. for students in grades 5 to 8
- offers a daily hot lunch that provides students with a nutritious hot entrée, sandwich, or salad
