SESSION DESCRIPTIONS

General Sessions/Skills Clinics – These sessions, for boys and girls, ages 7-15, of all skill levels and abilities, focus on individual skill development, the importance of fundamentals and the development of a healthy team attitude. Campers take part in a variety of games, competitions and fundamental drill work.

Future Stars Camp – The perfect introduction to organized basketball, these sessions allow boys and girls, ages 5-8, to develop proper habits at an early age. Youth-sized basketballs and 8-foot goals help bring the game down to their level.

Guard Clinic – These sessions are also for boys and girls, ages 7-15, and are designed to assist campers in building a solid foundation in terms of guard skills. We incorporate a variety of drills designed to improve ball-handling, shooting, passing, defense, decision-making and more.

Shooting Clinic – With a focus on developing and improving shooting mechanics and technique, these sessions are geared toward helping campers fine tune their shooting stroke. We incorporate a variety of drills designed to improve footwork, one-on-one moves, movement without the basketball, as well as, lay-up and jump shooting mechanics.

Parent/Child Camp – This unique camp experience allows parents to interact with their children in an exciting basketball setting. Parents and their children will be able to work on fundamental skills and learn about the game together on the Warriors home floor at Oracle Arena. This camp is for children ages 5-15 and their parent(s).

High Intensity Skills Clinic – This session is for boys and girls, ages 11-17. This clinic will give participants an opportunity to take part in an “NBA-like practice.”
