



SCRIP is a fundraising program that allows All Saints Catholic School to receive a percentage of the total amount participating families spend at a variety of stores, theaters, and restaurants. Some stores pay as little as 1%; some restaurants pay as much as 20%. The profits are fairly predictable and, as such, can be budgeted for in an effort to help keep tuition costs down.

Parents may buy scrip, which is basically like buying gift cards, and/or use e-Scrip.

There are several ways families can reach their scrip commitment:

- **PURCHASE SCRIP** - (gift cards) **daily in the school auditorium** between 3:00 and 3:30. The school stocks scrip for a variety of popular merchants, including but not limited to scrip for Longs, Home Depot, Macy's, and Savemart/Lucky/Foodmaxx.
- **ShopWithScrip.com** is a website where you may purchase scrip that is not regularly stocked at school. Further information will be provided at the start of the new school year.
- **E-Scrip** - If you shop at Safeway, please register your Safeway Club card number, along with your credit and debit cards. Safeway and other participating merchants make contributions to All Saints School based on purchases made by you (participating merchants are listed on the E-Scrip website). Our group ID is: 119143213. **E-Scrip requires ANNUAL renewal. To renew, go to www.Escrip.com before November 1st.**

HOW SCRIP PURCHASES ARE RECORDED

The Scrip Committee keeps computerized records of all Scrip gift card purchases.

E-scrip purchase records are available on-line to each family registered for e-scrip. Families are responsible for printing their e-scrip records and submitting them to the school office twice yearly. During the 2009-2010 school year, printouts are due in December and May, but may be turned in at any time. Printouts are to include purchases

made between June 1, 2009 and May 31, 2010 only. The school will take into consideration the time lag in the e-scrip reporting process when calculating fulfillment of scrip obligations.
